NEWS FROM THE CLERK

It is that time of year again! As many new people are moving to Wauconda Township and current residents are making changes, you may be wondering what residents should do and where you can find more information regarding the General Election approaching. I thought it would be helpful to share some important information. As always residents can always visit www. lakecountyil.gov to use as a great source to access information and services. You will be able to find vital records such as birth, marriage license, death certificate, election information and property taxes.

If you do not have access to the internet or a computer, you can call 847-377-2400.

Early Voting for the November 8, 2022, General Election will commence at the County Clerk's Office in Waukegan, 18 N. County St. in the main lobby; starting on Thursday, September 29th

and concluding on Friday, October 21st with operating hours of Monday through Friday 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. Early Voting will extend to the additional seventeen sites in Lake County starting Monday, October 24th through Monday, November 7th; per the specified locations, dates, and hours listed in this notice.

Grace Period Registration and voting will be offered at all Early Voting locations. Registered voters may access the Lake County Clerk's website at www.LakeVoterPower.info for information on their local Early Voting site. Each Early Voting site serves all Lake County voters. The local places where you can register to vote are Wauconda Township, Wauconda Library, Wauconda Village Hall and the Lake County Clerk's office located at 18 N. County St., Room 101, Waukegan. You can also register using the Illinois Voter Application on the Illinois State Board of Elections website. (You will need a valid Illinois drivers license or state ID)

If you are voting for the first time, you must vote in person and not vote by mail, unless the person first provides sufficient proof of identity, and the County Clerk verifies the persons proof of identity. People who apply to register to vote by mail but provide inadequate proof of identity to the County Clerk shall be notified by the County Clerk that the registration has not been fully completed. That person will remain ineligible to vote by mail or in person until such proof is presented. If you chose to register to vote by mailing in an application, your mail-in form must be postmarked prior to the close of the registration. Fun Fall Tips: Daylight Saving Time ends on Sunday, November 6, 2022, at 2:00 A.M. At this time, we "fall back" one hour!

Medicare Open Enrollment



Open Enrollment begins October 15, 2022 and runs until December 7, 2022. The Medicare Open Enrollment is an annual period of time when current Medicare users can choose to re-evaluate Part D (drug coverage) of their Medicare coverage and compare it against all the others on the market. New security measures require you to create a MyMedicare.gov account before you can receive personalized information. You may set up an account yourself or call Lisa Knight 847-526-1800 for an appointment and we can create one together.

The township maintains a medical equipment lending closet. Wheelchairs, walkers, rollators, shower chairs, transfer benches, commodes, toilet risers, canes, and bed rails are taken as donations and lent at no charge to people recovering from surgeries and/or injuries. These items may be borrowed for the duration of recovery or until clients receive a Medicare covered replacement.
